










# **UNBOXING 1**

Stack the items in the reverse order and latch


# If using queen excluder, make sure to:

- 1. Have the spacing pins facing down
- 2. Use the bottom slot of the latch (2a)










### **USING BOTTOM BOARD 1**






To enable pollen collection, the trap should be inserted all the way in. The pollen can be gathered from the drawer below.

To disable the pollen trap, pull it out completely as shown on right.

NOTE: Pollen is essential for bees! Enable the pollen trap (a) only when there is high pollen flow. It is not recommended to use it continuously. Please research about pollen collection before enabling the pollen trap




## **USING BOTTOM BOARD 2**






Whenever you remove the trap, close the slot with the red plug










### **USING HIVE ENTRANCE**



2 single holes above the outmost entrances are for drones

2 notches above the center entrances are to shut lock the sliders




The circular bee entrance piece can be set to be:

- a) Shut closed (handle on top)
- b) Ventilation (small holes on top)
- c) Queen entrance for mating flights (big hole on top)
- d) Additional hive entrance (horizontal slit on top)

## **HANDY FRAMES ASSEMBLY**



Remove the connecting sockets to release the frame components, then place the foundation sheet onto the lower component.







Position the upper component on top, taking care to align the pins.




Hold the frame together in an upright position and manually press the two components together to make them snap into one another.








#### **USING TOP FEEDER**







- 1. Remove the feeder top by holding from the center
- 2. Put the feed (Syrup or candy)
- Adjust the feed slot covers according to the feed. The feeder and these covers are designed to prevent bee drowning in syrup
- 3a. If feed is syrup make sure all the writings "Şurup" is outwards
- 3b. If feed is candy make sure all the writings "Kek" is outwards so bees can walk to the center of the feeder
- 4. Close the feeder top and adjust the yellow handles to secure slot covers

# **INNER COVER TYPE TOP FEEDER**



#### Solid Feeding

The cover reading "Cake" should be the outermost cover when feeding cake.

Built-in feeders of the inner cover enable solid and liquid feeding without having to open the hive, while both the hive temperature balance and the bees remain undisturbed.
